

California's Proposition 65 Compliance

The State of California's Proposition 65, the Safe Drinking Water and Toxic Enforcement Act, requires businesses to provide California consumers with "clear and reasonable" warnings of potentially hazardous chemicals present in their products. Warning labels are required on all products that contain chemicals found on the state's list of over 900 compounds and must specify that the product contains chemicals "known to the State of California to cause cancer and birth defects or other reproductive harm."

California Customers

Yarde Metals has reviewed our product line and some of our products are subject to the Proposition 65 regulation labeling requirements and bear the following warning label when shipping to California customers:

WARNING: This product can expose you to chemicals which are known to the State of California to cause cancer and / or birth defects or other reproductive harm. For more information go to www.P65Warnings.ca.gov

Non-California Customers

According to the regulations in Proposition 65, Yarde Metals is required to comply when shipping product to customers based in California. Non-California customers, who need to know if they are obligated to comply, can find the alloy's chemical composition on the mill certificates that are provided with each order.

It is the responsibility of the company selling material to customers in California to identify if their shipment should have the warning label attached. Yarde Metals is not authorized to make this determination for our customers based outside of California. Please refer to the mill certification provided with each order to evaluate if the warning label is needed.
